Rules and Conditions:

COMPETITIVE EXHIBITS

Anyone is eligible to apply for entry in the open exhibition at the Greater Houston Stamp Show (GHSS). The deadline for entry is August 1, 2010. Fees must accompany the attached Entry Form. An exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit, but a separate entry form is required for each exhibit. The minimum number of frames for an adult multi-frame exhibit is two and the maximum number of frames is ten. There is also a single frame exhibit class.

The GHSS committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. In such cases, the exhibit fees will be refunded. Failure to exhibit after notification of acceptance by GHSS will cause forfeiture of all entry fees. All material exhibited must be the property of the exhibitor. Pages must be numbered on the back and be in page protectors. Exhibits must not identify the exhibitor on the front of the exhibit pages in any way.

YOUTH EXHIBITS

Youths (exhibitors who will not have reached the age of 17 by the opening of the GHSS) are encouraged to enter an exhibit. Youth exhibits are limited to a maximum of five frames, and do not require an entry fee.

ONE FRAME EXHIBITS

One frame exhibits will be accepted from both youth and adults, but will be judged separately from the open competition. In addition to the regular one frame exhibits, there is a special one frame "orange" competition. "Orange" exhibits must be based in some way on the color orange, whether by the actual color of some element of the material or by a theme or topic related to the color orange. The acceptability of any exhibit to compete in the orange competition will be decided by the judges.

FRAME FEES

The entry fee for adults is \$6.00 per frame for multi-frame exhibits and \$10.00 for single frame exhibits. There is no entry fee for youth exhibitors. Please make all checks payable to "Houston Philatelic Society". Do not send cash.

FRAME SPECIFICATIONS

The frames are made to hold **16** standard album pages, four rows of four pages each. Larger pages or page protectors with outside punched flaps may require some overlapping. Exhibitors may specify fewer pages per row for oversized pages, but still must request the total number of frames required when filling in the Entry Form.

EXHIBIT SET-UP – TIME and DATE

The GHSS exhibits will be set up on Thursday, September 16th, between 3:00 PM and 6:00 PM. Any exhibits not available for mounting by 6:00 PM will be refused with no refund of exhibit fees. Exhibitors may either personally deliver their exhibits to the Humble Civic Center or have them delivered by mail or an agent.

MAIL-IN EXHIBITS

Mail-in exhibits must arrive by Tuesday, September 14th. **Do not send your exhibit by UPS or Federal Express**, as they will not deliver to a post office box. Forward all mail-in exhibits by either Registered Mail (this can take a week or more) or Express Mail to: GHSS c/o Ronald Strawser, P.O. Box 840755, Houston, TX 77284-0755.

EXHIBIT TAKE-DOWN

Exhibitors may retrieve their exhibits beginning 15 to 30 minutes after the show closes Sunday at 4:00 PM. No exhibits will be removed from the frames before 4:00 PM. Exhibitors wishing to have their exhibits returned by mail must include mailing instructions with the Entry Form and funds to cover the return mailing costs. If using an agent, the exhibitor must provide written authorization on the Entry Form for the agent to pick up the material after the show closes. Exhibits will be mailed back to the exhibitor within 48 hours of the show closing.

JUDGING

The GHSS committee will select a panel of three judges. The committee will endeavor to use APS accredited judges whenever possible, but emphasis will be placed on inviting judges with experience judging both local and regional sized shows. The decisions of the judges will be final.

Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to submit 4 copies of the title page, synopsis or bibliography in advance for study by the judges. This material should not include the exhibitor's name. The committee will distribute these pages to the judges in advance, but distribution will be limited to no more than three different pages per exhibit. For pages to be distributed, the committee must receive them by August 1, 2010.

AWARDS

Each exhibit will be evaluated by the judging panel and will be eligible to win one of the five medal levels: Gold, Vermeil, Silver, Silver-Bronze, or Bronze. The judging panel will also select the Grand Award and Reserve Grand Award winners. Society awards will be presented when available and when exhibits have met the society's requirements.

One frame exhibits will be judged separately, with their own set of awards given. There will also be special awards for the one frame "orange" competition.

Awards will be given out at an Awards Dinner scheduled for Saturday evening, September 19th. Further details and the cost of tickets will be available at a later date. Those not attending the dinner will receive their award during exhibit take-down or via the mail.

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

All reasonable care will be taken for the safe keeping of each exhibit, and armed guards will be on duty 24 hours a day at the exhibit facility, but neither the Houston Philatelic Society, its members, officers, or GHSS committee members, nor the Humble Civic Center, its employees or agents shall be liable for any damage or loss of any exhibit material arising from any cause or for any reason whatsoever.

Exhibitors desiring insurance must make their own arrangements.

An exhibitor's signature on the attached entry form signifies acceptance of these rules and regulations.
